#### Bickelhaupt Arboretum

*A fourteen acre outdoor museum of select, labeled trees, shrubs, ground covers, perennials and annual flowers. The Bickelhaupt Arboretum serves as a connection between people, plants and nature itself.*

*Visit the Lillian Russell Theatre aboard a fully restored old river paddleboat on Clinton's beautiful riverfront. Professional summer repertory theater runs from June through mid-August. Enjoy shows performed by young Midwest actors, Broadway professionals and local talent as they create a summer of theatre magic on the water.*



#### Eagle Point Park

*Picnic, hike or cross-country ski around this 200-acre park of spectacular bluffs along the river in Clinton. A 1937 Stone Tower provides a spectacular view of the Mississippi River and surrounding area. The north end overlook provides a panoramic view of the widest part of the entire Mississippi River.*

*New exhibits, in a variety of media, are hung every six weeks. The gift shop contains items created by talented local artists. During the year, classes and workshops, taught by local teachers and well-known artists, are held in painting, pottery, ceramics and drawing.*



#### Historical Society Museum

*Here, the story of early settlers of this Mississippi River area and the booming lumber business is told. Permanent collection includes old photographs of the area, memorabilia, period furniture, authentic 1924 kitchen, and the 'Resolute,' one of only three manually powered fire engines on display in the world.*
