One of the homesteads of the Cody family, built in stone in 1847 by the legendary native son's father. Guests can view the fully restored home, a stagecoach and buffalo that now roam the lands.

All of the homes and buildings included in the Historic District were constructed in the mid-19th century, mostly between 1850-1870, though style, form, size and materials of construction vary. Most prominent is the Italianate, with examples of both brick and frame construction. Enjoy self-guided tours of these historic homes.

A memorial and tribute to native son William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody, as well as a museum of Mississippi River history, native Indian artifacts and pioneer history. Wooden-hull sternwheeler The Lone Star, a national historic landmark, is on display, as well as a model of the "black box" used on airplanes, invented by Iowan James Ryan.



Mississippi River Lock & Dam No. 14

Highway 67 & Mississippi River, LeClaire

The movable portion of the dam is 1,343 feet (409.3 m) long and consists of 13 tainter gates and 4 roller gates. Connected to it is a 1,127 feet (343.5 m) long non-submersible rock fill dike which extends to the Illinois side. It was completed in two phases, the first from 1921 to 1924, which included a lock and canal bypassing a hazardous rapids. The second phase was part of the nine foot channel project from 1935 to 1939 and included the main dam and the current main lock.
